DID YOU KNOW?

• Veterans with cancer receiving chemotherapy through VA have higherquality care with respect to avoidable hospitalizations than Veterans receiving chemotherapy through Medicare. In adjusted models, roughly 7% of Veterans treated through Medicare had potentially avoidable hospitalizations in the 30 days following chemotherapy compared with approximately 5% of Veterans treated by VA.
