Did you know?

Each year, the Legion's Veterans Affairs & Rehabilitation Commission conducts a series of site visits to VA medical facilities and regional offices across the country to meet with veterans, their families and VA administrators and employees to discuss issues and solutions at each site. These observations are compiled into a System Worth Saving report that is distributed to VA officials, members of Congress and the public.

Legion to Testify on Veterans' Education, Homeless issues

American Legion employment and education policy associate Ricardo Gomez is scheduled to testify before the House Committee on Veterans Affairs' (HVAC) Subcommittee on Economic Opportunity.

Gomez will address the impact of school closures on veterans, including their access to their academic transcripts in the wake of abrupt school closures. Gomez will also testify in support of the Housing our Military Veterans Effectively Act, which seeks to grant the VA the use of funds to improve flexibility in providing assistance to homeless veterans.

MILITARY POLICY

Most of the major military policy changes to be passed by Congress this year will be unveiled over the next two weeks, as House and Senate lawmakers offer up their first drafts of the annual defense authorization bill.

The House Armed Services Committee will release their draft first, starting with seven subcommittee markups. The committee and its counterpart in the Senate are scheduled to finalize those proposals, sending them to the full chamber membership for votes later this summer.
